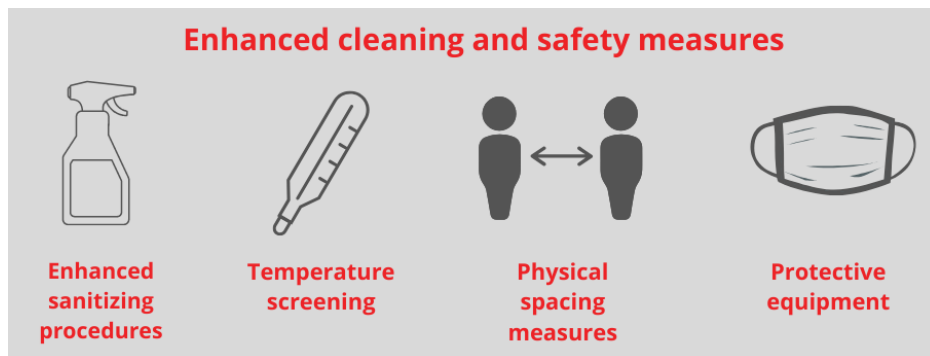




Dear Parents,

We want to assure you that we take the health and well-being of our community, customers, and associates very seriously. Like you, we're closely monitoring the quickly developing effects of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. The State Departments of Health strongly recommend frequently performing enhanced environmental cleaning of commonly touched surfaces and social distancing. In the case of our preventative cardiac screening program that means the following:

- **If you are sick, DO NOT come to the screening event.**
- **All screening participants will be asked to use antibacterial wipes/hand sanitizer prior to being screened.**
- **All screening participants will be asked to have their temperature taken with a touch free digital thermometer.**
- **ALL MCORE Foundation onsite staff/technicians will wear gloves and masks.**
- **All MCORE Foundation onsite staff/technicians will sanitize all equipment between each student screening.**
- **Appointment times are designed to only see one student at a time versus a mass screening and that minimizes the risk of passing something on to other students.**
- **All MCORE Foundation onsite staff/technicians will practice social distancing when possible.**
- **All event attendees should wear a mask if possible.**
- **We will allow no more than one adult to accompany a student, should that be necessary.**



We are all in this together. We will continue to monitor the COVID-19 situation and will follow guidance from public health officials and government agencies, so we can continue to support our screening partners and communities as needed.
