Ohio House Bill 113

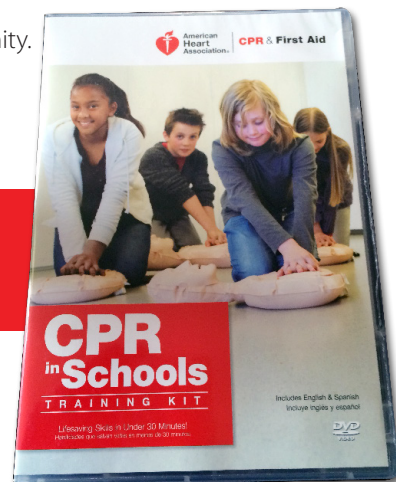
Passed on September 14, 2016, to require public schools in Ohio to provide CPR-AED instruction prior to high school graduation.

Program Details

The “CPR- ANYTIME PROGRAM” is to provide a basic understanding and opportunity to practice CPR and use of an AED in a classroom setting and is not a certification course. The class is approximately 35 minutes long with video and practice time. Each student receives a certificate of completion for the program. It is perfect for health class curriculum’s, teams or booster groups.
